

PROOF OF RESIDENCY ITEMS

The School code of the State of Illinois requires that a student attending any public school district within the State of Illinois be a BONA FIDE RESIDENT of that school district. A student must be living with the legally responsible person who is a resident of Arbor Park School District 145. At the time a student is registered, the legally responsible person will be required to provide proof of residency.

EVIDENCE FOR PROOF OF RESIDENCY PRESENTED:

IF REGISTRANT CANNOT PROVIDE CATEGORY 1 AND CATEGORY 2 PROOFS OF RESIDENCY, THE REGISTRANT WILL NEED TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING PACKET:

NOTICE TO REGISTRANTS UNABLE TO PROVIDE CATEGORY 1 AND CATEGORY 2 PROOFS OF RESIDENCY AND WILL NEED TO FURNISH ALL DOCUMENTS THIS NOTICE REQUIRES AS WELL AS PARTICPATE IN A RESIDENCY INVESTIGATION PRIOR TO ANY REGISTRATION PROCESS.

** NEW STUDENTS NEED TO PROVIDE: ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE, TRANSFER OUT PAPER FROM PREVIOUS SCHOOL DISTRICT, COPY OF LAST REPORT CARD, MEDICAL AND DENTAL RECORDS.
